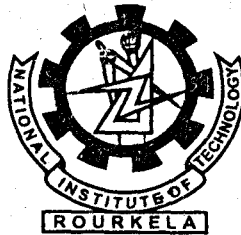

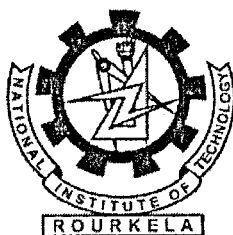

2006-12-Senate-4: Review and nomination of members to various Committees.

Senate confirmed the nomination of Director for the Chairmen and members of the Standing Disciplinary Committee. The Senate nominated Chairman and members of other Senate Committees listed in Annexure-I.

2006-12-Senate-5: Review of minimum qualification and specializations required for admission to M.Sc., M.Tech, M.Tech(Research) and Ph.D. Programmes.

The Senate briefly deliberated on the issue and authorized Dean(AA) to obtain complete information from the departments in a concrete and precise structure/format. HODs were requested to discuss the matter in detail in their respective DAC (PG & R)s and give their recommendations to Dean(AA) in the given structure/format which will be considered in the 13th meeting of the Senate to finalize the minimum eligibility criteria for the postgraduate programmes.

The pending case of Ms Babita Majhi of EC department was discussed. She had applied for admission to Ph D. programme in EC department with MCA qualification. The Senate decided that since the candidate is working in a project of EC department and her request has been recommended by the Department, her application may be accepted for Ph.D. programme.

However, this case may not be cited as reference in future for the purpose of fixing admission norms for the departments.

2006-12-Senate-6: Review of Policy on grade point requirement for graduation.

- a) Two students Shri Amit Pal Singh (CH) and Shri Binish N (CS) who have completed all courses with a grade of P or above in June 2006) could not score an overall CGPA of 6.00. As per existing rules, they can not graduate even when they have cleared all courses individually. Considering this unique scenario, Chairman Senate advised them to register again in three courses of Odd Semester and improve the CGPA.

The calculation shows that even if the students score a C or B in all the 3 subjects, their revised CGPA will not exceed 6.00.

To ensure that such scenarios do not recur the following policy decision are taken:

- 1) A student will not be permitted to register for the full set of higher semester courses if his CGPA falls much below 6.00 at any stage.
- 2) When a student repeats examination either as Supplementary Examination or appears as backlog paper the grade is reduced by one step. But when a student registers for a course and attends classes, there shall be no reduction in the grade awarded to him. This provision is applicable to all students irrespective of CGPA. But such students will not be eligible for medals and prizes.
- 3) A student may repeat any course with 'F' or 'P' grade for improvement if his CGPA falls below 6.00.

If a student secures 'F' grade in a course, he can improve the grade by writing supplementary examination, appearing in the following year as backlog course or by registering for the course.

If he has scored a 'P' grade, he can repeat it as a backlog course (not supplementary examination) or by registering afresh, only when his CGPA drops below 6.00. In all cases the Grade obtained in that particular course will be reduced by one step (except registering afresh/ when specially permitted otherwise by the Senate).

The following provision may be incorporated in the revised B.Tech. regulations;

B. UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES:

2006-12-Senate-07 Approval of Supplementary Examination Results :

B.Tech 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th Sem. Supplementary Results.

The results of B.Tech. courses as given in Annexure-II (P- 16 to 20) have been passed by the UGPEC held on 17.07.2006 and provisionally approved by Chairman, Senate. Senate may consider and approve the results.

Senate confirmed the approval.

2006-12-Senate-08: Status of B. Tech. 1st Year admission for the year 2006-07.

As per directive of the BOG , spot admission was done on 06.10.2006. Out of 14 vacancies, 11 students had taken admission in different branches. However, Sri Praveen Kumar Singh, one of these 11 students, who had taken admission in our institute earlier in the Mining Engineering department now got admission in the Electrical Engineering department. His case has been considered by the Senate to continue in his old group for the 1st year and his TA, Mid-Sem & End-Sem marks will be treated in line with other regular students. He will join his new group from 3rd Semester onwards. The Senate decided that there won't be any Mid-Sem examination (for 1st semester) for remaining 10 students, rather their End-Sem examination will carry 80% weightage. They are required to complete their sessionals with the help of Laboratory Assistants / Technical Assistants in the off hours.

2006-12-Senate-09: Awarding degree to Sri Sanjib Haldar in grade system.

Shri Sanjib Haldar, Roll No.M-01356 of B.Tech. programme had taken admission in the year 2001. Due to his illness he could not register in the 5th Semester in the academic year 2003-04 and was permitted to register in the academic year 2004-05. Thus, his evaluation in the first four semesters was done in the mark system and last four semesters in the grade system.

As per the approval of Director an Equivalence Committee was formed to decide whether he would be awarded degree in the marks system or grade system and to work out the necessary conversion.

The Equivalence Committee meeting was held on 12.6.2006 and recommended the following:

- a) Sri Haldar will be awarded degree in grade system.

- b) For the first four semesters, courses having 50 marks will be considered for 2 credits and courses having 100 marks will be considered for 4 credits and accordingly SGPA/CGPA will be calculated as per the current practice.
- c) Division and degree will be awarded in line with students graduating in 2006.

This has been provisionally approved by the Chairman, Senate.

Senate confirmed the approval.

2006-12-Senate-10: New Curriculum

Senate confirmed that the following two programmes of Computer Science & Engineering Department will be started from the Academic year 2007-08.

- i) M. Tech in Information Security.
- ii) Diploma in Information Security.

The HOD, Computer Science & Engineering was advised to modify the syllabi and place it before the Curriculum Development & Monitoring (CD & M) Committee, the recommendation of which will be placed before the 12th Senate for approval.

2006-12-Senate-11: Case of Sri Raj Kumar Kispotta, Roll No. 10403059

Sri Raj Kumar Kispotta, Roll No.10403059 (admission batch 2004-2005) was permitted to take readmission in 2005-2006 as he had secured less than 5.5 CGPA during the above period. As he could not secure 5.5 CGPA in the year 2005-2006 also, he was asked to discontinue his study after B.Tech. 1st year. Later his CGPA was changed from 5.36 to 5.71 as he has been awarded C grade in stead of I grade in COP Lab. by the concerned teacher. The I grade was erroneously counted as zero grade point in the original calculation which was corrected. Accordingly Chairman, Senate permitted him to register in 3rd Semester.

Senate approved his registration in the 3rd semester.

2006-12-Senate-12: Case of Sri Joginder Singh who had taken admission in B.E. chemical Engineering at REC, Srinagar in the year 1997.

Due to disturbance in Jammu & Kashmir, Sri Joginder Singh had migrated and was given admission in the 5th Semester (CH) at REC Rourkela in Sept. 2000 on basis of the order issued by MHRD with certain conditions. One of the conditions stated that, "You are to pass the course/courses not offered by REC, Srinagar but included in the curriculum of tyhis college in appropriate semester as decided by the equivalence Committee of the College". Accordingly, he had to clear five papers, as decided by the Equivalence Committee, out of which he could clear only three papers. But he had cleared all other requirements for the degree by 2002 and after that he was not available/ reported to the Institute. He had applied to appear Supplementary

examination – 2006 for those two papers on 11.05.06. As per then regulation he has to complete his B.E. Degree with in 8 years (by July, 2005) from the date of admission (1997). Considering the special circumstances under which Sri J. Singh migrated to NIT, Rourkela, Director (as Chairman, Senate) has permitted him to write supplementary examination in the 2 papers pending approval of Senate. But the candidate did not turn up to fill up form or appear at the Supplementary examination. Senate approved the permission given by the Chairman, Senate and decided not to give any further chance in future.

2006-12-Senate- 13: Approval of Supplementary Examination Results

2006-12-Senate-15: Anomaly in the name of the specialization “Biochemical Engineering & Biotechnology” for M.Tech programme in Chemical Engineering:

As per letter No.NITR./CH/Office/1179 dt.12.4.2006 from HOD Chemical Engineering, Academic Section made an Advertisement for admission to M.Tech programme for the Session 2006 – 07 as specialization “Biochemical Engineering and Biotechnology”. However, the Senate in its 11th meeting held on 11.5.2006 has approved the Specialization for Chemical Engineering branch as “Biochemical Engineering”.

Senate recommended the course name as M.Tech in “Biochemical Engineering and Biotechnology” to be amended in the BOG.

2006-12-Senate-16: Withdrawal (M.Tech.) before successful completion of course work . Case of Mr. Sandip Kr. Das, Mr. Ravindra Kr and Mr. Pitabas Sahoo.

i) In two of the 3 cases, the students have inadvertently been permitted to leave Institute before appearing 2nd semester end-sem. examination. To help the students, and simultaneously not to tax the teachers with extra paper setting, the following is proposed:

- a) The students may be permitted to write examinations along with 2006 entrants in April 2007.
- b) The mid semester marks and TA marks may be kept in the Department Office for inclusion with April, 2007 end- semester marks to calculate grade. The standard form may be used.

The proposal was accepted by the Senate.
